# **Construction Notice**

### WORK TO START AT BANK OF AMERICA PARKING LOT MONDAY, NOVEMBER 4<sup>TH</sup>, 2013 CONTRACT NO. 1252 (CENTRAL SUBWAY TUNNEL)

**Dear Neighbor:** Starting **Monday, November 4**<sup>th</sup>, Barnard Impregilo Healy Joint Venture ("the Contractor") will commence work within the Bank of America parking lot (behind 1455 Stockton Street, between Green Street and Card Alley). The Contractor will construct and excavate a shaft 20 feet in diameter and 27 feet deep. When excavation is complete, the Contractor will use a technique called "compensation grouting" to improve ground conditions when the Central Subway's two tunnel boring machines pass beneath Columbus Avenue. This work will last approximately six (6) months, finishing in the spring of 2014.

Additional details are as follows:

#### Location / Impacts:

- Bank of America Parking Lot (entrance on Green Street): The parking lot will be temporarily closed for the duration of the work. The banking drive through will remain open.
- Transit impacts: No transit impacts are anticipated.
- **Traffic impacts**: No traffic impacts are anticipated, with the exception of an increase in semi-truck traffic during the excavation phase.
- Parking impacts: Expect parking impacts around construction zones.
